


The Honduran Council for Voluntary Forest Certification CH-CFV was born in 2003 with the representation of various organizations, professionals and personalities of Honduran society linked to the use, management and conservation of forest and environmental resources as a need to support good forestry management and better image of forest products in the country and abroad.

Between 2003 and 2014, outstanding achievements were made in the departments of Atlántida, Yoro and Moskitia, resulting in certificates for forest management at the level of companies, community forestry organizations and indigenous peoples.

Promoting the FSC system became part of the VPA FLEGT platform in Atlántida, achieving recognition of the certification in the VPA FLEGT Voluntary Association Agreement; between the Government and the European Union (EU). In addition, there was an opening for the discussion of the public procurement mechanism as a market alternative for forest products at the national level. As a result, CH-CFV and FAO developed a national project to socialize the mechanism.
